

As the founding priest of St. Augustine Parish and University Chaplaincy JKUAT, Fr. Njoroge, entered into a memorandum of understanding with JKUAT management. Archbishop Mwana 'Nzeki approved this arrangement. Students of Architecture and Engineering, supervised by their lecturers, provided technical services, *gratis*, for the construction of the Parish House and Church. In return, this afforded them a practicum in industrial attachment a stone's throw away from the university. This win-win strategy has seen the project completed successfully.

Fr. Njoroge has rendered national service. In 2005, H. E. President Mwai Kibaki appointed him Member of the Public Universities Inspection Board (PUIB) through Kenya Gazette Notice 3089. The following year, Prof. Karega Mutahi, PS Ministry of Higher Education, appointed Prof. Njoroge as Member, National Strategy for University Education (NSUE). Both task forces delivered on their mandate and submitted reports duly to their respective appointing authorities. Fr. Njoroge has served as Visiting Professor at various universities including CUEA (2010-11). Besides supervising students at undergraduate and graduate levels, he has been External Examiner at Egerton University and Marist International College.

His research interests focus on the interaction(s) of religion, education and human progress in the developing world. A frequent contributor on the same motifs in local and global journals, he has published articles in Chicago Studies (ISSN-009-3718) and The Harper Collins Encyclopedia of Catholicism (ISBN-0-00-627931-7). He authored Century of Catholic Endeavour (2001). Fr. Njoroge contributed to a chapter in Global Perspectives on Gender and Sexuality in Education (2017).

In November 2019, Dr. Waldery Hilgeman, the Postulator of the Cause of Beatification and Canonization of the Servant of God Maurice Cardinal Otunga appointed Fr. Lawrence Njoroge as Vice Postulator of the said cause. The appointment was approved by H.E. John Cardinal Njue, Archbishop of Nairobi.
